

Midway Uhambo - Garden Route and Wild Coast

The Midway Uhambo (July 7-15) is an opportunity for participants to take a break from the rigors of the Summer Program and explore another region of South Africa. The Midway Uhambo is a combination of recreation/adventure activities as well as cultural and community visits. The Uhambo will start in the Garden Route where participants will be able to visit Tsitsikamma National Park (near Storms River), one of the most scenic and beautiful parks in all of Southern Africa. From there participants will visit Amakhala Game Reserve to go on a 3 day - 2 night Safari Experience. After the Safari, participants will visit Mthatha, a rural community in the wild coast of the Eastern Cape. Mthatha is where one of Sibanye staff, Sinesipho, is from and she will take us to her hometown and introduce us to the Xhosa Culture. Finally, the Uhambo will end in Coffee Bay where participants will be able to explore the natural beauty of the wild coast through stunning hikes and beautiful beaches.



- July 7: Fly to George and drive to Storms River
- July 8: Storms River: Visit Tsitsikamma National Park
 - Rafting or kayak/canoe tours,
 - Canopy tours,
 - Hiking
- July 9: Storms River to Amakhala Game Reserve for Afternoon Game Drive
- July 10: Amakhala Game Reserve (2x game drives)
- July 11: Amakhala (morning game drive) to Mthatha (community experience)
- July 12: Mthatha - rural community visit in the Wild Coast of South Africa.
- July 13: Mthatha to Coffee Bay
- July 14: Coffee Bay
 - Surfing and spending time on the beach
 - Hike to Mapuzi Caves
 - Hike to "Hole in the Wall"
- July 15: Coffee Bay to East London and return flight to Cape Town.
